Grafting materials, techniques for site development, block graft overview, titanium mesh and membranes

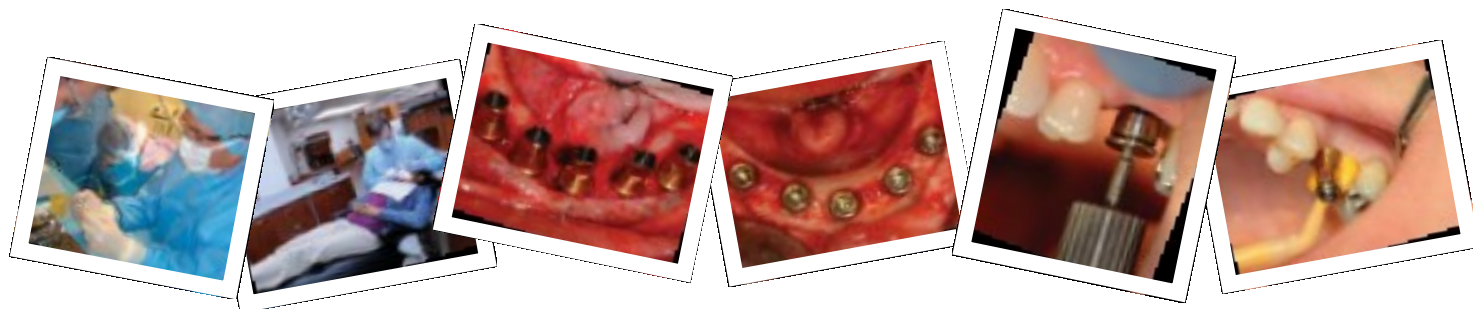
### 7-Sinus Grafting

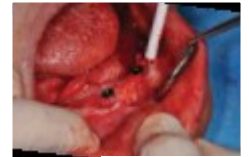
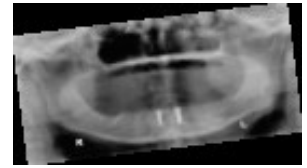
